Mike Kucha is a multi-functional, multi-discipline business advisor. He has over thirty years of business experience with both public and private companies as a CEO, board member, corporate lawyer, venture capital investor, and operator of his own company. At various times in his career, Mike has found himself on one side or the other of the investment table. His perspective includes that of companies looking for money and those investing it. From first-hand experience, he knows what it means to meet a payroll and the importance of finding investors in a timely fashion to maximize growth prospects.

He has found that for most companies fund-raising is a painfully inefficient process. He formed Timeline Advisers to address that problem by counseling early stage and growth companies, so they can proceed through the funding and capital formation processes in a more efficient and time-reduced fashion.

As a co-founder of Timeline Ventures, a San Diego based, high-tech venture capital firm, Mike provided a strong focus on operations and execution. Here Mike served as working chairman and interim CEO of Del Mar Datatrac, acquired by Fiserv (NYSE); Del Mar Datatrac grew from \$3.4 million in 2001 to over \$11.8 million in revenues in 2004, and yielded a 2.7X return for investors within 3 _ years.

Under the umbrella of Timeline Advisers, Mike has responsibility for overseeing the active investments in the portfolio of Timeline Ventures. These include: VizionWare, Inc., which designs, manufacturers, and sells digital interconnect devices for use in the HDTV space; NexPrise, Inc., which designs and sells a suite of supply chain management software; Emagia Corporation, which designs and sells cash management software; and TechnoCom Corporation, which provides operations software and services in the wireless telecom location-based services market. Mike is on the board of directors of Emagia and TechnoCom.

In addition, Mike, during his career:

- On two occasions, was turnaround CEO of Iomega Corporation (NYSE), a disk drive manufacturer; Iomega grew from a startup to over \$1 billion in annual revenues and at one point attained a market cap in excess of \$5 billion; it yielded almost \$300 million and a 100X return to the venture capital firm of which Mike was a partner.
- Managed the turnaround of Micro Automation, Inc., a semiconductor capital company, acquired by General Signal Corporation (NYSE); Micro Automation grew from a startup to a profitable business that yielded a 5X return for investors in six years.
- Was Chairman of GateField Corporation, a fabless semiconductor company, acquired by Actel Corporation (NASDAQ).
- Was acting CEO in the restructuring of a startup tape drive company, Exabyte Corporation.
- Was interim CEO of ERISS Corporation, an information services company.
- Served as chairman of PowerPlan Corporation, a budgeting and planning software company.
- Purchased and became CEO of the Dill Company, one of the two principal U.S. based manufacturers of generic price marking labels for the retail industry.
- Was a partner with Idanta Partners, a San Diego based, diversified investment and venture capital firm.
- Was chief legal counsel for Hydromation Filter Company (NASDAQ), a worldwide manufacturer of liquid filtration systems for the metalworking industry .
